- He was a contemporary of Isaiah, Amos, and Hosea
- He was from the southwest region of Judah
- He prophesied during the reigns of kings Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah
- His messages were mostly directed toward Jerusalem
- He is considered to be one of the Twelve Minor Prophets

This sermon series will take us through the rest of Easter, and concludes May 16.
